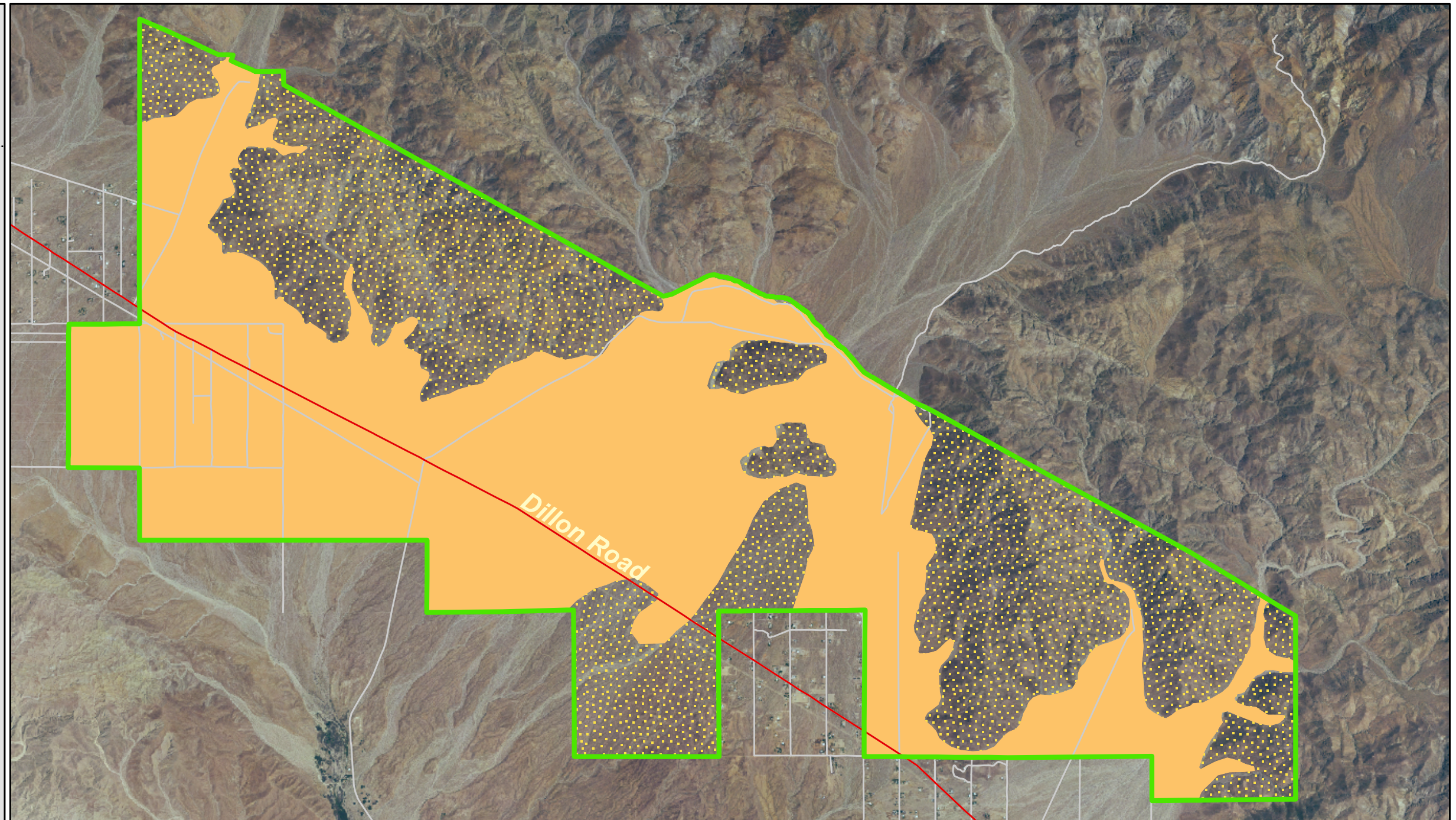

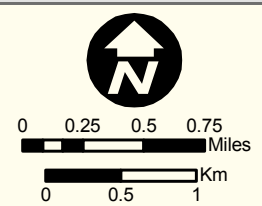


Figure 4-18d: Indio Hills/Joshua Tree National Park Linkage Conservation Area
