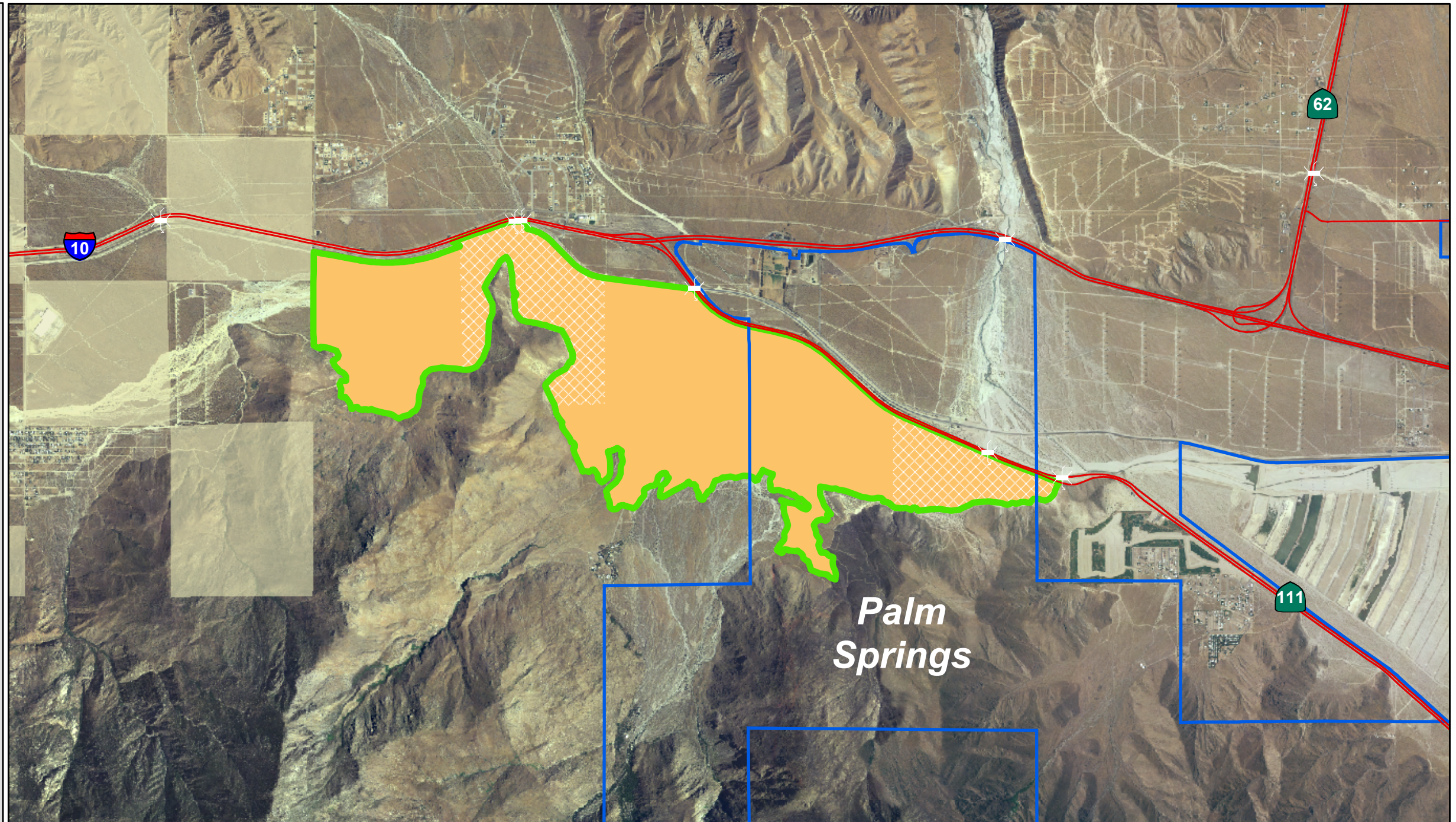

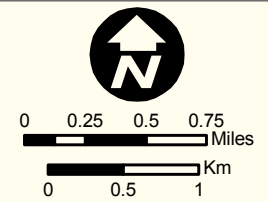


Figure 4-8d: Snow Creek/Windy Point Conservation Area
