# BALANCING ECONOMIC GROWTH WITH HABITAT CONSERVATION

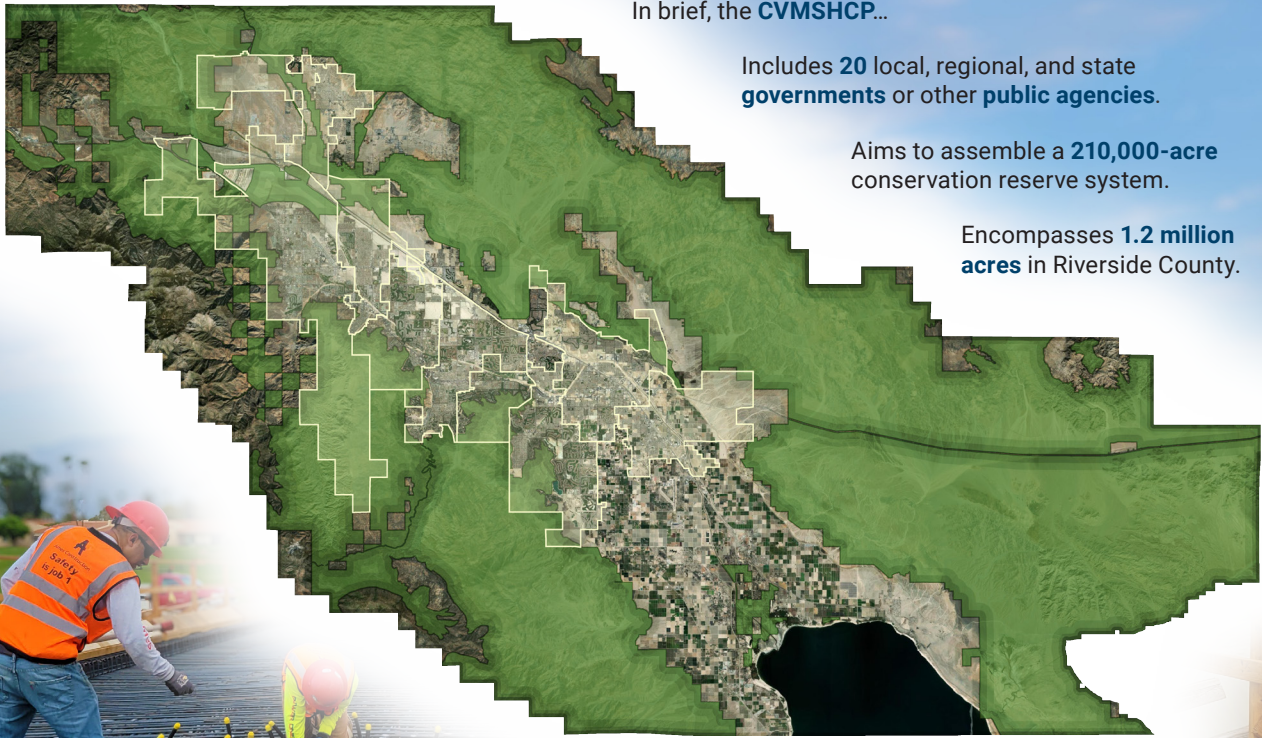
The **Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan** is a 75-year vision streamlining environmental permitting for development and infrastructure projects while protecting designated plants and animals native to the Coachella Valley.

In brief, the **CVMSHCP**...

Includes **20** local, regional, and state **governments** or other **public agencies**.

Aims to assemble a **210,000-acre** conservation reserve system.

Encompasses **1.2 million acres** in Riverside County.



**Conserves 27 natural communities**, like sand dunes, mesquite hummocks, and fan palm oases.

**Maintains the essential ecological processes** of wildlife linkages and sand transport corridors for wind and water.

**Protects habitats for 27 species**, like the Peninsular bighorn sheep and Coachella Valley fringe-toed lizard.



The CVMSHCP is administered by the Coachella Valley Conservation Commission on behalf of participating public agencies.
