


## BALANCING ECONOMIC GROWTH WITH HABITAT CONSERVATION

The Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan is a 75-year vision streamlining environmental permitting for development and infrastructure projects while protecting designated plants and animals native to the Coachella Valley.



Conserves 27 natural communities, like sand dunes, mesquite hummocks, and fan palm oases.



Maintains the essential ecological processes of wildlife linkages and sand transport corridors for wind and water.



**Protects habitats for 27 species**, like the Peninsular bighorn sheep and Coachella Valley fringe-toed lizard.
